

# Set supplier information

#### Minimum information required:

E-mail address

#### Additionally (if applicable):

- Customer number per outlet
- Minimum order amount (only warning, no blocking)
- Fixed delivery days



# Set delivery details per outlet

Is on the order overview for the supplier:

- Sender name
- Delivery address
- Procurement responsible (e-mail)



### Create order + send

- Use filters to quickly find products, for example per supplier.
- You can create an order directly via "create order" or via "bill of materials" for a recipe or menu.
- Do you often order the same? Create an order list!
- Par = level to which you want to replenish the stock, maximum order quantity
- Minimum stock = critical stock
  - Turn on notifications when minimum stock is reached.
- Aggregated stock = all stock for this item, the orderable and non-orderable packages. For example, we have 0 crates of beer, but still 12 bottles of beer. I can only order a crate of beer, not a single bottle, the aggregated stock will be 0.5 crates of beer.



# Register a delivery

- Important to check delivered quantities and prices.
- Invoice information can be added afterwards.
- Delivery date and time is only informative, no recalculation of stock in the past is made.
- Update price = Update price at ingredient level for the next order.
  - Not recommended for temporary promotions.
- Save delivery = add delivered items to stock at the price set, this cannot be undone!
- Procurement report = summary of the delivered orders over a certain period.



## **External order?**

- If you want to enter a delivery in Apicbase so that it is added to your stock, without first sending an order email.
  - Important: stock item must be known to the selected supplier in the system!
